# PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES BELOW THE ALICE THRESHOLD

Those living below the ALICE Threshold include individuals in poverty and **ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed)**. Typically undercounted and overlooked, ALICE lives paycheck to paycheck – earning above the poverty level, but less than the cost of household basics.

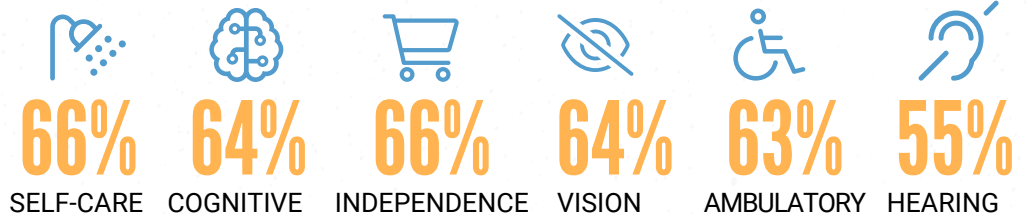
